ORDER

Respondents' served and filed a motion to dismiss this appeal, contending Appellants have failed to comply with the South Carolina Rules of Appellate Procedure. Specifically, Respondents' contend Appellants have failed to timely order the transcript or serve and file Appellants' Initial Brief and Designation of Matter. Appellants did not file a timely return. Accordingly, Respondents' motion to dismiss is granted. *See* Rule 207(a)(1), SCACR (providing that Appellant shall, within ten days after the date of service of the Notice of Appeal, make satisfactory arrangements in writing with the court reporter for furnishing the transcript and contemporaneously furnish all counsel of record and the clerk of this Court with copies of all correspondence with the court reporter); Rule 208(a)(1) (providing that Appellant shall serve and file Appellants' Initial Brief within thirty days after serving the Notice of Appeal if no transcript is ordered); Rule 260 (providing this Court shall issue an order of dismissal whenever Appellant fails to comply with the requirements of the South Carolina Rules of Appellate Procedure).
