ADA Accommodation Request / Request for Extension

Ms. Kitchings:

Please be advised, in reference to the above case and your letter of April 7, 2023, that I have submitted a \$50 filing fee for my ADA Accommodation Request by first class mail. The fee is paid by way of Western Union money order #19-437463941.

I would additionally ask you to confirm that the South Carolina Court of Appeals charges filing fees for ADA accommodation requests, as I believe the Court ordinarily does not and, per federal law, cannot charge filing fees for disability accommodation requests. I have made numerous ADA accommodation requests associated with my attention deficit disorder in this Court and other South Carolina courts and have never been previously charged for such request.

I would also respectfully request you consult with the South Carolina Office of Court Administration on the matter, as it is clear that equal protection requires that South Carolina courts have a consistent and uniform policy on whether ADA accommodation requests are subject to filing fees, and since I know from prior personal experience that many South Carolina state courts do not charge for ADA accommodation requests (and have never met one that did charge), it is legally problematic that the South Carolina Court of Appeals charges such fees.
