

2022: * 8.75% = \$243,521.70 (based on interest of \$19,593.70)

However, the Defendants noted that during 2021, it would have been impossible to try this case for a majority of the year since courthouses were closed to prevent the spread of COVID-19. As such, the Court is inclined to reduce the interest amount by one year to reflect this inability of the parties to try their case during that time. The Court therefore ORDERS that one year of interest shall be tolled. The Court further finds that Plaintiff is entitled to interest on the remainder of the years outlined.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the judgment in this case will reflect prejudgment interest. The judgment will be increased from One Hundred Sixty Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$160,100) to Two Hundred Twenty-Three Thousand, Nine Hundred Twenty Eight Dollars (\$223,928). This amount will be reflected on the judgment roll for Orangeburg County.
