Thank you for your letter of April 7<sup>th</sup>. At present, I do not need to request relief from the Court and the purpose of my prior letter was merely to advise the Court of discussions between the parties.

In short, a dispute developed between the parties regarding the contents of the Record on Appeal as the Appellant has objected to certain material that the Respondents have designated. As we have designated material pursuant to Rule 210, SCACR, I believe the material is to be included in the finalized Record on Appeal, to be prepared by the Appellant, or the Appellant should file an objection with the Court under Rule 240. I believe all material that we designated was properly designated pursuant to Rule 210, as matter which was presented to the lower court or tribunal.

Given this, the Respondents do not have a motion to make and do not seek relief. We are awaiting the finalized Record on Appeal or a motion from the Appellants.
