I have your letter of March 23, 2023 stating there would be no further review of my case unless I file a timely petition for Writ of Certiorari the S. Carolina Supreme Court. I am not going to file a petition. I have already addressed this issue in my last Motion stating that it is evident there has been no hearing/review of my Motion to reinstate the appeal, and certainly no review of my Declaration of Matter which was sent along with my final brief, but returned by you to me in July 14, 2022, for me to return when the Record on Appeal was due. I received no notice of a scheduled hearing/review and certainly no review of my Declaration of Matter. There was also no listing on the docket. Guess this is going to be like the missing tape and Order from the Probate Court hearing on May 19, 2021 at 11:00 A.M.

I am in the process of obtaining new counsel to file a Breach of Trust with Fraudulent Intent against Paulette Stovall, and William Stovall in the Greenville criminal courts. I know that there has been perjury and attempted and actual unlawful manipulation of Trust assets, as well as evasion of Federal and State tax laws. The main issue is that I have never received any tax return evidence filed at the time of my father's death, nor any statement of Trust assets and expenditures from that time to date to which I am entitled by law. This long drawn- out saga has been to avoid an audit and the required reports. Those who have nothing to hide, hide nothing.

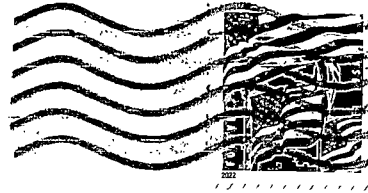
