Dear Ms. Allen:

Received a letter from you dated May 21, 2013 addressing me as counsel again. You are giving me twenty (20) days to file the same thing your letter to me dated April 25, 2013 giving me thirty (30) days to file. Your letter dated May 21, 2013 is before the time is up on the letter dated April 25, 2013.

Received two (2) letters from you dated April 25, 2013 on the same day. One of the letters was telling me to correct any deficiencies on the final brief that I filed with your office giving me ten (10) days. The other letter dated April 25, 2013 stated that you never received the final brief. How can your office tell me to correct deficiencies on something it never received? I filed my final brief once again on the 21st and sent it return receipt. Someone in your office signed for it. No disrespect intended but this office has had me file certain documents over and over stating that it never received them.

As I explained in my letter answering your letter about the deficiencies of the Appellant's final brief you said you did not receive in the other letter that I am not counsel and your letter dated May 8, 2013 addressed me as Mr. Thompson. Your letter dated May 21, 2013 has addressed me as counsel again.

I am a pro se indigent inmate and have filed most of my briefs twice because your office keeps saying they did not receive them. I file one (1) original and 15 copies of my final brief of which my girlfriend made the copies for me because I cannot afford to do it.

I have filed everything your office has asked me to file to the best of my knowledge and ability. I have showed all the proof necessary to prove my case that I deserve redress. Fleming v. Rose is the same as my case and Fleming got justice in his case, so should I.

No disrespect but how can so many documents keep not being received? I have showed proof of service and still asked to file again. I keep a copy of everything I file with the Court.

I am an indigent inmate and should not be held to the same standards as an attorney. I have a receipt for the last documents I filed with your office.

Once again this letter is not meant to be disrespectful. I am very confused at the demands from this Court.

Thank you so very much for addressing this matter.
