

ORDER

This appeal arises out of a writ of ejectment entered by the magistrate court. Because this court lacks jurisdiction, this appeal is dismissed.¹ *See* S.C. Code Ann. § 27-37-120 (2007) ("Either party may appeal in an ejectment case and such appeal shall be heard and determined as other appeals in civil cases from the magistrate's court."); S.C. Code Ann. § 18-7-10 (2014) ("When a judgment is rendered by a magistrates court . . . the appeal shall be to the circuit court of the county wherein the judgment was rendered . . ."). The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
