The victim stated that she knows the suspect but doesn't know her name. The victim stated while she was inside the Refuel at the register, the suspect started a verbal altercation with her. The victim stated when she walked back to her vehicle, the suspect walked back to her vehicle, grabbed something and walked back to her in a fast pace and stabbed her in her arm with a large silver kitchen knife.

That the victim did receive medical attention at Roper St. Francis in Mount Pleasant Hospital where she received ten stitches from a laceration. I was advised by the medical staff that the laceration was 3 to 4 inches deep.

With malice a forethought the defendant attempted to cause serious injuries to the victim, Ms. Gathers by stabbing her with a knife. That the victim was able to positively identify the suspect from a photo line-up.

All of the above is believed to be true based on the investigation of Detective G. Jenkins and is against the law, peace, and dignity of the State of South Carolina.

With malice a forethought the defendant attempted to cause serious injuries to the victim, Ms. Gathers by stabbing her with a knife. That Assault and Battery in High and Aggravated Nature is defined as a violet crime under 16-1-60.

That the victim was able to positively identify the suspect from a photo line-up.

All of the above is believed to be true based on the investigation of Detective G. Jenkins and is against the law, peace, and dignity of the State of South Carolina.
