Dear Hon. Justice:

The trial judge erred in this case, and the prejudicial error affected appellant's substantial right that resulted into a life without possibility parole sentence pursuant to section 16-11-311(B).

In the instant case, the trial judge erred in amending indictment number #1993-GS-40-9530 and indictment number #1993-GS-40-9516 with indictment number #2005-GS-40-3548, 3477, 3935, 3940 and 4169 is prejudicial. The appellant's contention that all of his 1993 sentences and his first conviction or sentence in case number #1993-GS-40-9530 should be invalid because the written judgment therein differed from the oral judgments. Due process requires transcript of record to confirm factual or legal position pronounced in the presence of the appellant in open court and not those set out in the written judgment of the court. See, Rule 35, Fed. R. Crim.P.

Further, at the trial on November 30th, 2022 the state and custodian of evidence admission in open court, no out of court statement such as eyewitness, witness or expert testimony assists in identifying Adams is guilty of this particular crime.
