In 2019, this Court granted Ms. Davis's motion to remand her case to the Lexington County Court of General Sessions to reconstruct the record of her sentencing hearing from April 30, 2014. Following a hearing before the Honorable Walton J. McLeod, IV, this Court remanded the case back to the circuit court for a new battered spouse hearing by way of a January 14, 2022 Order.

Counsel for both parties met with Judge McLeod in August 2022 for a status conference. I am taking steps to prepare for the upcoming battered spouse hearing, to include investigation and identification of relevant evidence. I am nearly ready for the hearing and will coordinate with opposing counsel and Judge McLeod to schedule a date, likely this summer.

I have been appointed Appellate Defender on this case and have notified the Court on April 10, 2023 of this change. Taylor D. Gilliam will serve as co-counsel. Another update will be provided next month. If you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact me.
