I have the notification you sent to Paul Wickensimer about the Remittitur. Also enclosed was the decision of the court sent by V. Claire Allen. I have addressed this issue several times in letters and filed Motions because the order states that I failed to file an emended brief which is absolutely not true. This emended initial brief was filed in your offices on October 17, 2022 and properly served on all parties. Also filed with the brief was a Declaration of Matter. That Declaration of Matter was returned to me by Claire Allen on July 14, 2022 (see attached). stating that it should be resubmitted when the Record on Appeal is Due. I never received any notification on when that was due and it is still sitting here on my desk.

Now I have also received notice that my Motion for a hearing/review was denied because there had already been a hearing/review so would be considered a rehearing. I was never notified of any kind review or hearing. Since that did not take place and my declaration of Matter was never looked at, that is not possible. I have already stated that I intend to file a suit in the civil court for Breach of Trust with Fraudulent Intent if a settlement cannot be reached out of court, or if the court does not issue an order for a full accounting of the Trust assets; or preferably transferring the accounts to the Arthur State Bank in Greenville as the Trusts state should happen if the Trustees do not agree to a settlement, cannot serve, or there is a problem. Obviously, there is a real problem, growing bigger every year for the past four years.

I am discussing this matter with new prospective counsel in Greenville, as well as with an attorney here who specializes in this area. A response from you would be appreciated.

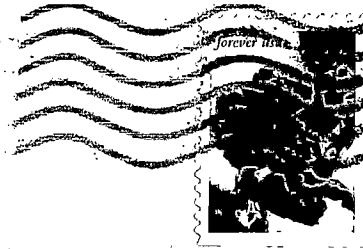
