Thank you for your letter responding to me about the *pro se* party in this case.

I will grant you this is a little confusing, given the pseudonyms, and I am not trying to deepen any confusion, but in the trial court that individual is a party designated by one of the enumerated Johns Doe numbers. He was one of the class representatives. In theory he was represented by class counsel, but he is now adverse to class counsel and appeared *pro se* in recent proceedings.
