That JOSHUA WYTE KELLEY did in Pickens County on or about the 23rd day of February, 2021, did unlawfully cause physical harm or injury to KELLI HARRIS, a household member or did unlawfully offer or attempt to cause physical harm or injury to KELLI HARRIS, a household member, with apparent present ability under circumstances reasonably creating fear of imminent peril and JOSHUA WYTE KELLEY committed the offense under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life and the offense resulted in great bodily injury to KELLI HARRIS or JOSHUA WYTE KELLEY committed the offense with or without an accompanying battery and under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life, and would reasonably cause a person to fear imminent great bodily injury or death. This is in violation of § 16-25-0065 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976) as amended.
