Our firm represents the Appellant, Randy Bowers, in the above referenced matter. We wanted to provide you with a status of the production of the Transcripts in the above-reference matters.

The court reporters for the trial were divided into three different court reporters. We were under the impression that there were only two court reporters, Stacy S. Johnson and Steven E. LeBlanc. We were under the impression that the three days of trial were divided between Ms. Johnson on November 16, 2022 and Mr. LeBlanc on November 17 and 18, 2022.
