Appellant received Plaintiff's Motion To Hold Appeal In Abeyance, claiming there are references made in Appellants Initial Appeal Brief, the Plaintiff has no access to being there has been no transcript of record prepared and claiming there are documents referenced that are not in the States procession.

Appellant motioned as a indigent to have this court to order a transcript of record be paid for and prepared.

This Court did not make a ruling within the time frame of SCACR, Rule 208, and with out a transcript, Appellant had to present his Initial Brief Of Appellant with only verbative references to the events which occurred at the (presumed SCC Ann. 44-48-110 hearing).

Appellant was due to provide a copy of the Designated Matter after the Respondent was expected to have filed a Reply Brief pursuant to SCACR, Rule 208.

Instead the Respondent filed [tier] Motion For Abeyance of Appeal.

As such to move this case forward, Appellant would request for the Court to make a ruling as to the matter of the transcript.

If / the Court does order the transcript be paid for and provided, then Appellant would move for Leave to submit a Amended Initial Brief Of Appellant that includes references to the transcript of record.

And at that point the appeal can continue.


