Appellant's motion to strike Respondent's initial brief is granted. Within thirty days of the date of this order, Respondent shall serve and file an amended initial brief that complies with Rule 208 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. *See* Rule 208(b)(2), SCACR ("The brief of respondent shall conform to the requirements of Rule 208(b)(1)(A)-(F) . . ."); Rule 208(b)(1)(E), SCACR ("The brief shall be divided into as many parts as there are issues to be argued. At the head of each part, the particular issue to be addressed shall be set forth in distinctive type, followed by discussion and citations of authority. A party may also include a separate statement of facts relevant to the issues presented for review, with reference to the record on appeal, which may include contested matters and summarize the party's contentions."). Appellant shall serve and file his reply brief within ten days of service of Respondent's amended initial brief.
