
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FILING RETURN TO APPELLANTS'
PETITION FOR REHEARING

Respondent, Bank of America, N.A., moves for an extension of time to file its return to Appellants' petition for rehearing.

Based on the proof of service attached to the petition, the due date for filing the return falls on Monday, July 1st. Counsel for Respondent received the petition on Monday, June 24, as shown on the attached exhibit - a copy of the envelope. The intervening weekends deprived Respondent of a significant part of the period allowed under the Rule 240(e), SCACR for filing

the return. Respondent had, in effect, only four days to prepare the return. Respondent's attorney has been in court for almost the entire week beginning on June 24, 2013, and has not had sufficient time to prepare a response. Therefore, Respondent requests that the time for filing the return be extended by additional seven days, until July 8, 2013.


