*Comes Now*, Appellant Christopher Jones-pro se, pursuant to Rule 240 SCARC, and upon motion for a final extension of time to secure a copy of the hearing transcripts from the Greenville County Court of Common Pleas and exemplifying extraordinary circumstances.

For the sake of brevity, the Appellant will refer to the Record of this Appeal regarding his attempts to secure and provide the South Carolina Court of Appeals with a copy of the hearing transcripts.

On May 12, 2023 this Honorable Court graciously granted Appellant until May 27, 2023 to provide the Court with the transcripts of the January 9, 2023 proceedings before Judge Verdin. In his attempts, Appellant was informed by the South Carolina Court Administration office that the hearing was captured and recorded by WebEx.

On May 18, 2023 this Appellant wrote and called the South Carolina Court Administration's office and was informed of the process in obtaining a WebEx transcript. Appellant took the necessary steps, however by May 31, 2023 Appellant had not received any response from his previous

mailings to Court Administration. Appellant then reached out to the South Carolina Court Administration inquiring of the status of the transcript requests. It was at this time that Ms. Jacobs informed the Appellant that Court Administration had not received the mailings and gave Appellant the enclosed email address.

On May 31, 2023, Appellant received confirmation that the January 9, 2023 transcript was being prepared and the costs thereof would be sent to Appellant within five days. (Enclosure).

Also on May 12, 2023, the South Carolina Court of Appeals ordered that the May 12, 2023 extension would be the final extension, absent some extraordinary circumstances. The Appellant through nothing but good faith efforts has been diligently pursuing the transcripts of the January 9, 2023 hearing since the outset of this appeal. The Appellant further believes that these occurrences involving acquiring a WebEx transcript through the South Carolina Court Administration qualifies as "extraordinary circumstances" because these events were beyond the control of the Appellant.

Based upon the response from the S.C. Court Administration, the Appellant believes that he is likely to receive the transcripts as indicated by the most recent email from S.C. Court Administration.


