1. In this action, Plaintiffs sued Ken Ard in his official capacity as President of the South Carolina Senate and Glen McConnell, as senator from Charleston County, who served as vice chairman of the Charleston County Delegation, and by virtue of that office, served on the Charleston County Aviation Authority.
2. Since the filing of this lawsuit, Glen McConnell has become the Lieutenant Governor and President of the South Carolina Senate, and George "Chip" Campsen has taken McConnell's place as vice chairman of the delegation.




Dear Ms. Singletary:
