ORDER

Appellant move to proceed *in forma pauperis*. The right to proceed *in forma pauperis* must rest upon a statute or a fundamental constitutional right. *Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995). Appellant has the burden of showing his entitlement to this relief, but he has not done so. Therefore, Appellant's motion is denied. The filing fees for the notice of appeal (\$250) and the motion to stay (\$50) must be paid within fifteen days of the date of this order. Failure to provide the filing fee may result in dismissal of the appeal.
