

## ORDER

---

Appellant's motion to file an amended notice of appeal that includes the circuit court's December 6, 2021 order granting summary judgment for Robin Maples and/or the December 21, 2021 order denying reconsideration, is denied. *Olson v. Fac. House of Carolina, Inc.*, 344 S.C. 194, 214, 544 S.E.2d 38, 48 (Ct. App. 2001), *aff'd*, 354 S.C. 161, 580 S.E.2d 440 (2003) (holding the grant of summary judgment to one defendant in an action with multiple defendants *must* be immediately appealed, otherwise "a dismissed party would be 'on hold' indefinitely"); Rule 203(b)(1), SCACR ("A notice of appeal shall be served on all respondents within thirty (30) days after receipt of written notice of entry of the order or judgment.").

Respondent's motion to strike is granted in part and denied in part.<sup>1</sup> The following items from Appellant's designation of matter shall be stricken: (9-11), (14-15), (21) and (34). Respondent's motion is otherwise denied. Within thirty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall file an amended designation of matter and initial brief excluding the stricken items and any references thereto.
