By order filed May 8, 2023, this Court asked our office to screen Mr. Booker for indigency to complete his appeal. On May 12, 2023, our office mailed an affidavit of indigency to Mr. Patrick Booker to complete and return to our office by June 1, 2023. We received the original affidavit of indigency on May 19, 2023. On May 23, 2023, we sent out a supplemental affidavit of indigency so Mr. Booker could provide some additional information we needed on one of the questions on the affidavit. Our office had asked for this supplemental affidavit of indigency to be returned to our office within ten (10) days of the date of the letter, which would be June 2, 2023. As of today, we have not received the supplemental affidavit of indigency back from Mr. Booker.

If the Court needs additional information, or wishes for our office to take additional action, please contact me. Otherwise, we will close our file since we are unable to adequately screen Mr. Booker for indigency.
