MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO
SERVE AND FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Quinterious R. Truesdale respectfully requests a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension June 9, 2023 until July 10, 2023**, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Quinterious R. Truesdale respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.


3. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant and the Record on Appeal in the murder case of The State v. Earl Gene Johnson, Jr. with the Court of Appeals on June 1, 2023. Counsel is presently working on the Initial Brief of Appellant in the murder case of The State v. Gabriel Curry, which has a lengthy transcript and many exhibits, and he intends to file the brief and designation of matter with the Court next week. Counsel is second chair in South Carolina v. Angela Brewer in which a brief in opposition to the state's petition for writ of certiorari was filed on Monday, May 15, 2023. Counsel was on scheduled vacation from May 1-13, 2023. Counsel filed the Reply Brief of Petitioner for the capital appeal in the case of Marion Alexander Lindsey v. The State on or about April 28, 2023. Counsel filed the Initial Reply Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Bowen Gray Turner with the Court of Appeals on April 25, 2023. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the death penalty case of The State v. Timothy Ray Jones, Jr. on April 13, 2023. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the murder case of The State v. Dabry Aunta James with the Court of Appeals on April 5, 2023. Counsel appeared before the Supreme Court for oral argument in the murder case of The State v. William C. Sellers on Thursday, March 30, 2023. Counsel and co-counsel Lara M. Caudy filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Bowen Gray Turner with the Court of Appeals on March 16, 2023. Counsel appeared before the Supreme Court for oral argument as the respondent in the attempted case of The State v. James Caleb Williams on March 8, 2023. Counsel conducted a CLE presentation and training on Preserving the Record for Appellate Review for the Sixteenth Circuit Public Defender's Office on March 3, 2023. **Counsel also has extensive administrative duties as the Chief Appellate Defender.**

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

5. On May 31, 2023, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through June 30, 2023.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension from June 9, 2023 until July 10, 2023**, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances.
