ORDER

Respondent has filed a Motion to Dismiss, or in the Alternative, to Strike Matter from Appellants' Initial Brief and Designation of Matter. After careful consideration, we find Appellants' Initial Brief contains material that does not comply with the requirement of Rule 208(b)(1)(B), SCACR, that the Statement of Issues on Appeal "be concise and direct as to each issue."
