



ORDER

On April 18, 2023, this court dismissed this appeal because Appellant failed to provide proof of service that the notice of appeal was timely made on Respondents as required by Rule 203(b)(6) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. On April 28, 2023, Appellant filed a motion for reinstatement of the appeal, which we construe as a petition to rehear the dismissal.
