Also enclosed for filing, please find an envelope containing the original and one copy of the un-redacted version of the initial brief, which is being filed under seal pursuant to the Court's order dated May 16, 2013 (copy enclosed). Please file stamp and return the extra copies of these materials via our courier.

We also ask for your guidance on how to proceed in the future when filing the final briefs and the record on appeal. The Court's order provides in pertinent part:

Accordingly, the parties shall redact their filings with this court to the extent necessary to protect Respondent's privacy. [T]he parties may file unredacted versions of their filings under seal together with redacted versions for the public file. These sealed unredacted documents should be filed in a separate appendix and the bottom of each page of the appendix shall be marked "Sealed."

(Order at p. 2, citation omitted). I am uncertain on precisely what the court desires regarding the "appendix" of unredacted filings. Should this appendix include the unredacted final briefs of the parties and the unredacted record, bound together in a single document? If so, how many copies of the appendix should be filed? Also, when filing the redacted versions of the final briefs and the redacted record on appeal, how many copies of each should be filed?


