ORDER

On March 30, 2023, Attorney Colie J. Stancil moved to be relieved as counsel for Appellant. On May 2, 2023, this court issued an order warning Appellant of the dangers of self-representation, pursuant to *Faretta v. California*, 422 U.S. 806 (1975), and allowing him thirty days to notify this court whether he wished to proceed pro se. Appellant has now informed this court he wishes to proceed with representation.

Accordingly, we hold this appeal in abeyance for thirty days from the date of this order to allow Appellate Defense to screen this matter pursuant to section 17-3-310(G)(2) of the South Carolina Code. This court will act on Attorney Stancil's motion to be relieved upon receipt of a response from Appellate Defense.
