



## ORDER

---

By order dated May 17, 2023, this Court appointed William Harry Ehlies, II, and Derek Joseph Enderlin as Petitioner's counsel in this matter. We further determined counsel would be compensated at the rate of \$115.00 per hour as set by the PCR court and shall split any compensation associated with the appointment, but that counsel may move this Court for attorney's fees and costs at the conclusion of the matter. Counsel have now filed a motion for clarification of our prior order. In the alternative, Counsel move to be relieved.

We clarify counsel will be compensated at the rate of \$115.00 per hour each. Counsel may bill the Commission on Indigent Defense, Division of Appellate Defense (the Commission) separately at the rate of \$115.00 per hour. The total compensation for both attorneys shall not exceed the statutory cap for reimbursement from the Commission unless Counsel file an appropriate motion for additional compensation at the conclusion of the case.

Counsel's motion to be relieved is denied.
