## ORDER

This matter is before the Court on a petition for a writ of certiorari following the denial of Petitioner's application for post-conviction relief. Petitioner also has filed a motion to amend the Clerk's Office's rejection of his attempt to file documents *pro se* while represented by counsel. Finally, Petitioner has filed a motion to proceed *pro se*.

The petition for a writ of certiorari is denied. Further, the motion to amend the Clerk's ruling is denied. *See Foster v. State*, 298 S.C. 306, 307, 379 S.E.2d 907, 907 (1989) (holding there is no constitutional right to hybrid representation). Finally, Petitioner's motion to proceed *pro se* is denied.
