This afternoon I filed a Petition for Rehearing/Request for Reconsideration of Order of Dismissal in the above captioned matter. As I mentioned at that time I just had oral surgery day before yesterday, I had one molar pulled and my gum cut open to grind down bone spikes that were left after my first oral surgery in April. That section of gum had to be cut back, the bone ground down and the gum stitched closed during the surgery I had this past Wednesday. I had continued to be in pain since my first surgery and It turned out that jagged spikes of bone were left under my gum following the extraction of a major molar in April. Between that procedure, and the extraction of yet another molar that had broken since my surgery in April, I have been in a lot of pain since April 18, 2023. I came to my office today for the purpose of filing a Petition for Rehearing /Request for Reconsideration. I did the best I could, but it was difficult. This evening I read the Petition and realized it needed serious editing. I have remained at the office at this hour in order to properly edit my earlier filing. I am attaching my Amended Petition, and copies of Attachments A-E from my petition as an attachment to the Petition. I have also attached my COS on opposing Counsel. It appears I have somehow attached each of these items twice. I am afraid to mess with them any further tonight. Please excuse the

duplicates.

I realize I need to file a petition for leave of court to substitute this Amended Petition for Rehearing for the version I filed earlier, but I am just too ill to stay later tonight. I will come in the office again tomorrow and draft and file that Petition. Thank you very much for your kind assistance in filing these documents.
