ORDER

Petitioner has filed a *pro se* petition for writ of certiorari in this matter. Because Petitioner is represented by counsel on appeal and because the Court of Appeals has not issued a final ruling in this matter, the petition is stricken and dismissed. *See* Rule 242(a), SCACR ("The Supreme Court . . . may issue a writ of certiorari to review a *final decision* of the Court of Appeals." (emphasis added)); *Foster v. State*, 298 S.C. 306, 307, 379 S.E.2d 907, 907 (1989) (holding there is no constitutional right to hybrid representation on appeal).
