> Dear Ms. Kitchings:

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> I am aware that I need to file a status letter concerning the transcript request by today. Unfortunately I have been out sick a good bit with dental issues that resulted two oral surgeries the last of which was June 21, 2023 I apologize that this caused me not to write the Court sooner.

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> I ordered this transcript and the Court Reporter acknowledged receiving the request very promptly. She subsequently sent me the estimate for the transcript to be produced. I advised the client's mother and she forwarded the funds to me fairly quickly. I wrote a check to the court reporter and made a copy of the original request to send to her with my check. I believed it went out in the outgoing mail from my office on that date. Unfortunately I later found that letter with my check in closed on my desk and realized it had not been put in the outgoing mail.
