



ORDER

After careful consideration of the petition for rehearing, the Court is unable to discover that any material fact or principle of law has been either overlooked or disregarded, and hence, there is no basis for granting a rehearing. Accordingly, the petition for rehearing is denied. However, we revise the portion of Opinion No. 5987 on the issue of the directed verdict to state "Tammy sent Victim and others angry texts about the affair during the six weeks preceding Victim's disappearance," instead of "Tammy sent Victim angry texts about the affair throughout the six weeks preceding Victim's disappearance."
