of conviction(s).

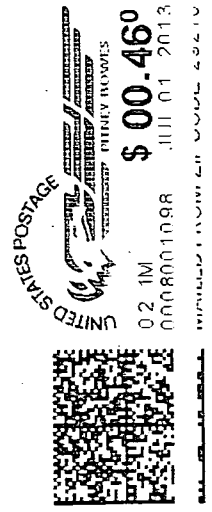

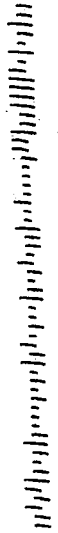
