


## ORDER


Pursuant to Rule 222 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, the motion for costs filed by the South Carolina Workers' Compensation Commission (the Commission) is granted in the amount of \$132.36 against Kelاهر, Connell & Conner, P.C. After careful consideration, the Commission's request for \$2,500 in attorney's fees is denied. *See Austin v. Stokes-Craven Holding Corp.*, 406 S.C. 187, 199, 750 S.E.2d 78, 84 (2013) (explaining that "it is within [the appellate court's] discretion whether to award fees and costs under Rule 222"). The lower court or tribunal is directed to add the award of \$132.36 in costs to the remittitur.
