2. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals and Appendix in the case of The State v. Gary M. Wirtz with the Supreme Court on July 3, 2023.


Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. James B. Curry with this Court on June 29, 2023. Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of Justin Ryan Cone v. The State with the Supreme Court on June 23, 2023. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals and Appendix in the case of The State v. Calvin D. Ford with the Supreme Court on June 19, 2023.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

4. On June 30, 2023, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through July 31, 2023.




