Dear Counsel:

On June 16, 2023, the Court of Appeals requested a return to your client's motion to relieve you as counsel. Pursuant to our records, and by operation of Rule 264, SCACR, you remain counsel of record for the appellant. You must file the requested return within 10 days of the date of this letter.

Additionally, after further review of the file, it appears this appeal is from a guilty plea. Pursuant to Rule 203(d)(1)(B)(iv), SCACR, "[y]ou must provide a written explanation showing that there is an issue which can be reviewed on appeal. This explanation should identify the issue(s) to be raised on appeal and the factual basis for the issue(s) including how the issue(s) was raised below and the ruling of the lower court on that issue(s). If an issue was not raised to and ruled on by the lower court, the explanation shall include argument and citation to legal authority showing how this issue can be reviewed on appeal. If the appellant fails to make a sufficient showing, the notice of appeal may be dismissed." You must file a guilty plea explanation within 10 days of the date of this letter, and provide proof the explanation was served on your client as well as the State.

If you have not responded to this letter within 10 days, the Court will take further action.
