I represent the Defendant/Appellant Composite Resources, Inc. ("CRI") in the above-referenced trial and appellate causes. I have copied my co-counsel hereon.

On July 7, 2023, CRI timely perfected an appeal from a summary judgment in Cause No. 2019-CP-00051. On July 11, 2023, the South Carolina Court of Appeals assigned the appeal Cause No. 2023-001103.

We are in the process of confirming we have all the necessary transcripts in completed/final form for purposes of the appeal. In that process, we have determined that the transcript for the January 20, 2023 proceedings (attached hereto for your convenience) contains multiple references to “inaudible” portions of the proceedings that were not transcribed as a result of “remote platform interruption and audio interference throughout the hearing.”

As you may recall, we initially requested a transcript of the January 20 proceedings on an expedited/rush basis. Accordingly, CRI respectfully requests that the court reporter undertake another effort to discern and transcribe those portions of the proceedings that are currently demarcated as “inaudible” in the attached transcript.
