## ORDER

On June 15, 2023, this court dismissed Appellant's appeal for failure to provide a written explanation for why his appeal from his guilty plea should proceed. By letter dated June 16, 2023, Appellant requested an extension of time to provide the required explanation, noting the correctional institution where he resided had been on lockdown for several weeks, which prevented him from providing a timely response. We construe Appellant's letter as a motion to reinstate the appeal, and we grant the motion. Appellant shall provide this court with a written explanation showing that there is an issue which can be reviewed on appeal within twenty days of the date of this order. *See* Rule 203(d)(1)(B)(iv), SCACR. Failure to provide the court with the written explanation may result in dismissal of this appeal.
