number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of Justin Ryan Cone v. The State with this Court on June 23, 2023. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals and Appendix in the case of The State v. Calvin D. Ford with this Court on June 19, 2023.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.
