I WAS DIRECTED TO YOU BY MY FAMILY FROM THE OFFICE OF THE NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR ICAOS IN D.C. BECAUSE NEITHER ME OR MY FAMILY COULD FIND S.C.'S ICAOS REPRESENTATIVE'S CONTACT INFO ONLINE, BUT MY FAMILY WAS ASSURED BY THAT OFFICE, THAT YOU WERE PROFESSIONAL, OBJECTIVE, AND WORKED CLOSELY WITH THE NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR ICAOS AND WOULD ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH THE COMPACT.

WITH THAT BEING THE CASE, I'M NOT SURE THAT YOU'RE AWARE OF MY SITUATION WITH THE SCDPPPS'S NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THE ICAOS COMPACT'S RULES AND REGULATIONS IN MY 'RETAKING' AND REVOCATION OF AN OUT-OF-STATE PAROLE TRANSFER, OR IF THE AGENCY IS KEEPING THE PARTICULARS OF THIS CASE FROM YOU?

SCDPPPS CLAIMED A BREACH OF THE ICAOS AGREEMENT IN THEIR 'PAROLE VIOLATION WARRANT' BUT ABANDONED THE ICAOS PROCEDURES FOR A 'RETAKING' AS OUTLINED IN RULE 5.108(A-C) AND INSTEAD PROCEEDED WITH THEIR CUSTOMARY WAYS OF EXTRADITION, THEREBY SKIPPING ALL OF THE DUE PROCESS PROTECTIONS INCORPORATED INTO THE COMPACT. I AT NO TIME ABSCONDED OR CHANGED APPROVED RESIDENCES WITH OR WITHOUT PERMISSION.

AS I'M SURE YOU'RE AWARE, THE ICAOS RULES AND REGULATIONS ARE BINDING ON THE COMPARTING STATES UNDER: § 24-21-1220(B)(2) AND SUPERSEDE EITHER INDIVIDUAL COMPARTING STATES CUSTOMS UNDER: § 24-21-1220(A)(2), AND ARE CONSIDERED AS STATUTORY UNDER: § 24-21-1130(2) SCDPPPS'S DEPARTURE FROM THE MANDATORY LANGUAGE OF THE COMPACT VIOLATED THE DUE PROCESS CLAUSE OF THE CONSTITUTION.

THE S.C. ATTORNEY GENERAL ISSUED A LENGTHY OPINION AND EXPLANATION OF DISCREPANCIES THAT AROSE BETWEEN STATE STATUTES AND ICAOS THAT HAD YET TO BE RULED UPON IN APPELLATE COURT AND THIS EXPLANATION ADDRESSES MY CONCERN OF THE ICAOS 'RETAKING' PROCESS BEING SKIPPED AND VIOLATING DUE PROCESS RIGHTS. IN 2008 WL (S.C.A.G.) 317746, IN PARAGRAPH 6 (SUBTITLED "YOU ALSO INDICATED THAT:") LINES 9-11 "THE DECISION TO 'RETAKE' DOES NOT OCCUR UNTIL AFTER THE SENDING STATES RECEIPT OF THE HEARING OFFICER'S REPORT AND DETERMINATION." SEE RULE 5.108(F)...

AFTER THE ISSUANCE OF THE WARRANT AND EXECUTION OF THE EXTRADITION, IN AN ATTEMPT TO SATISFY THE ICAOS REQUIREMENTS, WAS IN THE WRONG STATE AND PROVIDED NO PRESENTATION OF EVIDENCE, NO OPPORTUNITY FOR CONFRONTATION OF ACCUSER, NO OPPORTUNITY FOR CROSS-EXAMINATION OF ADVERSE WITNESSES, NO INSTRUCTION OF RIGHT TO HAVE OR HIRE COUNSEL, AND NO FAIR, UNBIASED HEARING ADMINISTRATOR.

This States wholesale departure from the Compact has caused me a loss of my Conditional Liberty and violated my Constitutional Due Process Rights. And the Commission has the authority to intervene in the sake of Equity and to right an injustice. I am sending, enclosed, a copy of my most recent appellate Brief to outline and further explain my concerns and also, its in accordance with S.C. CODE 1976 § 24-21-170(B), (2) to provide the Commission with "all service of process in any proceeding for all purposes". (B), (2): "The Interstate Commission shall attempt to resolve any disputes or other issues which are subject to the Compact". (Other issues" on this case being Non-Compliance with the Compact Rules by a Compacting State.) Intervention is warranted.

South Carolina is supposed to have an ICAOS Commissioner or Representative to ensure its States Compliance with the Compact. Being as, the S.C. Representative is associated with the agency who is being Challenged for Non-Compliance to the Compact, a conflict of Interest arises because, adherence is Non-Existant in this case.

S.C. skipped the entire "Retaking" process outlined in ICAOS Rules 4.109 & 5.105(A-C) which was put in place to protect Due Process Rights, and instead proceeded under their customary extradition practices, skipping the Preliminary Probable Cause Hearing in the Receiving State and relied on a S.C. 
