ORDER

The parties jointly move for an order allowing them to substitute copies for the original items of evidence in the Appendix in this matter because the original items cannot be located. The motion is granted, and the Appendix may contain copies of these documents rather than the originals.

The parties also ask this Court to order the Richland County Clerk of Court to correct the record to include the copies of the exhibits. In the alternative, the parties request a remand to the lower court to obtain an order to correct the record from the Chief Administrative Judge as the presiding judge has retired. Because there is no need to correct the lower court record, the requests to order the correction or to remand for a correction are denied.

Finally, the parties ask to stay the time limits in this matter during the pendency of this motion. Petitioner shall serve and file the petition for a writ of certiorari and the appendix within thirty days of the date of this order.
