Dear Judge Shearouse,

I am writing this letter to request permission to submit a *Writ of Certiorari* in the above captioned case. This is a Post-Conviction Relief case.

After a telephone conversation with my client on or about May 5, 2013, we agreed to dismiss this action, and a *Notice of Dismissal Without Prejudice* was mailed to the Court on May 8, 2013, with a copy also being sent to Assistant Attorney General Ashleigh R. Wilson. On or about May 22, 2013, Ms. Della White contacted our office to inform us that we needed to have Mr. Norris White sign an affidavit stating that he consented to the dismissal. The affidavit was mailed to Mr. Norris White on June 6, 2013 for his signature. After two weeks without being able to contact Mr. White, Ms. Della White called the office to check on the status of the affidavit. Finally, on June 20, 2013 I was able to speak with my client on the telephone, at which point he indicated that he no longer wanted to dismiss the case and has chosen to proceed with the matter. Ms. Della White suggested that I write to you personally to see if we may still submit the *Writ of Certiorari*.


