MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO ORDER TRANSCRIPT OUTSIDE
OF FILING DEADLINES IN RULE 207, SCACR

Appellant hereby moves pursuant to Rules 207 and 263(b), SCACR, for permission to request the transcript outside the filing deadlines and for an extension of the time in which to make such request. Specifically, Appellant seeks permission and an extension of that time to 16 days from the date that Appellant’s transcript request was due (July 17, 2023) to the date the transcript was requested (August 2, 2023). If permission and the request is granted, Appellant’s transcript request will be treated as timely.
