EXTENTION OF TIME TO FILE 3 MOTIONS BY AUGUST 10, 2023

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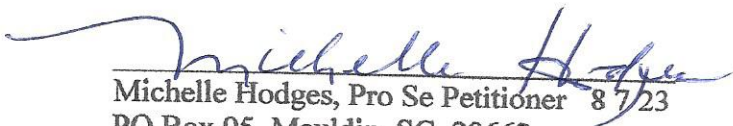
Pursuant to South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, Rule 263 Petitioner requests an extension of time to file 3 motions by August 10, 2023 (3 days from today) and pay the filing fees within the required 5 days due to the financial costs, which will be \$200.00 including this motion.

This is Petitioner's second request for an extension of time, with the first request being made on January 4, 2023 for a 15 minute delay in filing.

Petitioner makes this request because Respondent's return implied that Petitioner's Writ of Certiorari did not meet the standard of SCACR, Rule 242(b) and Petitioner respects the South Carolina Appellate Court rules and procedures and Petitioner has a desire to provide this Honorable Court with a legally sound petition, along with 2 motions, to continue to defend Petitioner's ownership rights in the subject property.

There is no prejudice to Respondent, because void orders cannot gain validity and Respondent is aware or should be aware that the Orders issued in its favor appeared to have been void upon issue.
