
Dear Ms. Ruffin:

Upon reviewing your appellant's initial brief, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this matter will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Specifically, the proof of service provided states that the notice of appeal was served.
- The document has not been signed as required by Rule 267(b), SCACR.
- The appellant's initial brief must be double spaced pursuant to Rule 267(c), SCACR.
