SECOND AMENDED SCHEDULING ORDER


This matter comes before the Court following a remand from the Honorable Donald C. Coggins, Jr. of the United States District Court. Further, the Supreme Court of South Carolina, pursuant to Article V, Section 4 of the South Carolina Constitution has vested this Court with exclusive jurisdiction of this matter. It appears to this Court that a Scheduling Order is needed in this case due to (1) the time constraints placed on this matter by the District Court and (2) the need to keep the Supreme Court of South Carolina apprised of the progress in this case. On March 3, 2023, this Court held a status conference. Pursuant to those conversations, the Court enters the following Second Amended Scheduling Order¹:

1. All discovery has been produced;
2. By text order dated February 3, 2023, Judge Coggins granted an extension for this matter until September 18, 2023. Therefore, setting a deadline for motions or a date to commence the hearing is premature at this time;
3. The next status conference will be held May 5, 2023 at 10:00 a.m. to discuss further scheduling matters;

4. The parties shall continue to apprise the Court of any new developments in the federal litigation.
