## ORDER

---

When Petitioner failed to timely serve notice of appeal on counsel for the State, the Court dismissed this matter. Petitioner has now filed a motion to recall the remittitur. Because the remittitur was properly sent, this Court no longer has jurisdiction over the matter. *Wise v. S.C. Dep't of Corr.*, 372 S.C. 173, 174, 642 S.E.2d 551, 551 (2007) (holding that unless the remittitur was sent down by mistake, error, or inadvertence of the Court, once the remittitur has been sent, the appellate court no longer has jurisdiction over the matter). Therefore, we deny the motion to recall the remittitur.

Petitioner has also submitted a motion for reconsideration and a request to strike his criminal history from the record. These requests are denied.
