

ORDER


On June 14, 2023, this appeal was dismissed for failure to provide a sufficient guilty plea explanation pursuant to Rule 203(d)(1)(B)(iv), SCACR. However, the court received Appellant's pro se guilty plea explanation on June 26, 2023. We construe the filing as a petition to rehear the dismissal. After careful consideration of the issues raised by Appellant, the court is unable to discover the existence of any preserved issues for this court's review, or that any principle of law has been either overlooked or disregarded; hence, there is no basis for granting a rehearing. Accordingly, the petition for rehearing is denied.
