ORDER

Petitioner's application for post-conviction relief (PCR) was denied on January 4, 2013. Petitioner served a *pro se* Notice of Appeal from the order on April 12, 2013. Because PCR counsel indicated she received the PCR order on January 15, 2013, and the Notice of Appeal was not served within thirty days after that date, the Notice of Appeal was dismissed on March 29, 2013.

Petitioner has now filed a *pro se* request for the Court to reconsider the order of dismissal. The motion for reconsideration is denied without prejudice to petitioner's right to seek relief pursuant to *Austin v. State*, 305 S.C. 453, 409 S.E.2d 395 (1991).
